



Free Central Park Walking Tour

Tour begins from northwest corner of 59th St. and 5th Ave ([map](#))

Look for our guide at the base of the William Tecumseh Sherman Statue (photo below)

Tour ends 72nd St. and Central Park West ([map](#))

Tour lasts approximately 1hr 45min

Total Distance is approximately 1 mile (1.6 kilometers)

Q: Can you give me directions to the tour and back from the tour?

A: Written direction are listed below. However, we have provided Google maps for both the tour starting and ending points. Google maps allows you to input your starting or ending address (hotel, house, etc) and will give up updated and accurate walking, driving and most importantly mass transit directions. Best - **5th Ave/59th Street** subway station - **N Q R**. When you exit the station, you will be on the north side of 59th Street, just across from the Plaza Hotel. The park is north. Walk east for one block. You will see the statue on your left across Grand Army Plaza (1min)

From **Lexington Ave/59th Street** subway station **4 5 6** - Exit at 59th Street and walk west (with vehicle traffic) for 3 blocks until you arrive at Grand Army Plaza. The statue will be on your right (7min).

From **59th Street (Columbus Circle)** subway stations **1 2 A B C D** - follow 59th Street (Central Park South) east for 3 blocks (the park will be to your left while you walk). (10min).

Q: What is an appropriate tip/gratuity?

A: Another good question. People always ask why we offer a tour for free that our competitors offer for \$20-25/person?
